

## **School Uniform**

- Students are expected to be in full school uniform.
- Students must wear plain black shoes that have no logos or decorative elements.
- Boots and trainers are not allowed. Backless, suede or cloth footwear is not allowed.
- Students can wear belts, but they must be plain black with no studs or decoration.
- School shirts must fit properly and must have a top button.
- Linen trousers are not acceptable.
- Jewellery is not allowed in school. A single watch may be worn. One stud earring in each ear, a flat ring and a charity bracelet are the only items allowed to be worn in school. Any jewellery confiscated will be placed in an envelope and returned to students on the following Friday. A detention will be issued.
- Skirts should be A-line and knee length.
- Students are only allowed to have natural hair colouring. Greens, blues, reds etc are not allowed. Any student with inappropriate hair colour will be removed from circulation. Inappropriate fashion hairstyles are not allowed. Students will be removed to isolation and only allowed back in mainstream lessons when the style is appropriate.
- Make up is banned in KS3 (Year 7 & 8). This includes false nails, false eyelashes and nail varnish.
- Make up can be worn, but must be removed unless applied sparingly, in KS4. False nails, false eyelashes and nail varnish are not permitted in KS4.
- Students arriving in coats, scarves and gloves must only wear them outside the building. Hoodies are not to be worn on site.
- Students can remove their blazers in class with staff permission, but they must have their ties and top buttons fastened. Shirts must be tucked in whilst on the premises.
- Blazers can be taken off outside the building during break and lunchtime periods.
- Smart watches used for any other purpose other than a watch, will be confiscated.

Black socks or for girls wearing a skirt, black opaque tights

**Skirts**

The skirt must be a straight A-Line style, as in the Image opposite, and should sit either just above or just below the knee. Any skirt that is more than one inch about the knee is not deemed suitable for school. Please note that pleated or tight fitting skirts are not allowed.

**Trousers**

Trousers should be plain black and straight leg. Tight fitting or skinny style trousers are not permitted. Suitable trousers are shown in the image adjacent.
