## SCHOOL UNIFORM

School uniform plays an important part in helping to create a smart and businesslike community of learners, who share common goals and values. Our school uniform has been decided upon after much consultation with students, parents, guardians, carers, staff and governors.

The school expects all students to comply fully with its uniform code. Students who do not comply with the uniform expectations can expect **either**

- the uniform to be corrected (for example, a tie or blazer to be lent to them) **or**
- to be removed from circulation and supported in their learning until the issue is resolved.

It is a parent's, guardian's or carer's responsibility to ensure that his or her child is correctly prepared for school.

The uniform requirements are:

### BOYS

Black blazer  
Blazer badge  
White shirt  
Black trousers

School tie  
School grey and red trim jumper (optional)  
Black leather or leatherette shoes (not canvas)

Black socks  
Plain Coat – Navy or Black

### GIRLS

Black blazer  
Blazer badge  
White shirt  
Black tailored trousers or plain black A line skirt to just above or just below the knee.  
(Not pleated / not tube or tight fitting /not lycra)

School tie  
School grey and red trim jumper or cardigan (optional)  
Black leather or leatherette shoes (not canvas)  
Black socks or black, opaque tights  
Plain Coat – Navy or Black

The P.E. uniform requirements (**for boys and girls**) are:

Black shorts  
Black football socks  
Training shoes (clean for indoor use)  
School rugby shirt  
Football boots (**only** Astroturf type or plastic stud type)  
Towel  
Shin pads (for football and rugby or hockey)  
White sports socks (**girls only**)  
(Tracksuit bottoms are permitted in cold weather. A mouth guard is strongly recommended for contact sports.)

The following are **NOT** allowed:

- Training shoes (except for use in P.E. or on the tennis courts or the school field)
- Coloured nail varnish
- Jewellery (except one stud earring per ear and one flat ring)
- Excessive make-up
- “Extreme” hairstyles and colour. As a guide hair should be natural colours. (Please consult us if you are unsure of the suitability of a style or colour.) Any hair accessories should be subtle.
- No fleece jackets or sweatshirts

Supplementary equipment. Students should be provided with the following items of equipment: ball point pen or fountain pen, pencil, ruler, calculator, rubber, coloured pencils and protractor. An old shirt may be useful for art and craft lessons.
